

**AGREEMENT FOR RECIPROCAL MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES
BETWEEN
THE UNION OF PHYSICISTS IN BULGARIA
AND
THE AMERICAN PHYSICAL SOCIETY**

The American Physical Society (APS) agrees to extend reciprocal membership privileges as defined below to individual members of the Union of Physicists in Bulgaria (UPB), and the UPB agrees to extend reciprocal membership privileges as defined below to individual members of the APS.

- 1) Members of the UPB may submit papers to APS meetings with the same privileges and limitations as APS members; and
- 2) UPB members may register at APS meetings at member rates.


Conversely,

- 1) Members of APS may submit papers to UPB meetings with the same privileges and limitations as UPB members; and
- 2) APS members may register at UPB meetings at UPB member rates.


This agreement shall remain in force until either the Union of Physicists in Bulgaria or the American Physical Society gives 12 months' notice of termination or a wish to renegotiate the agreement.
